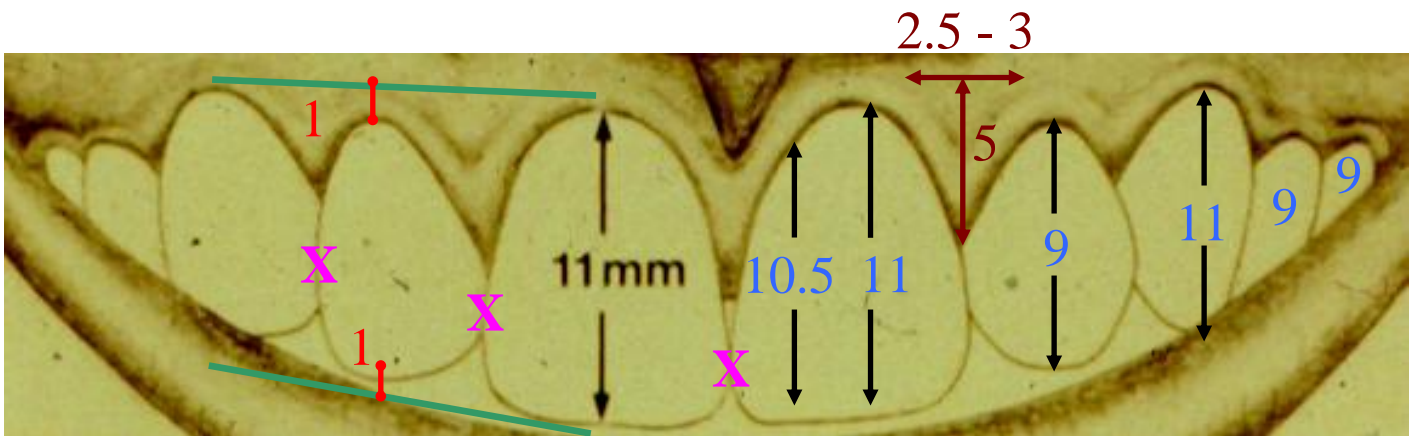
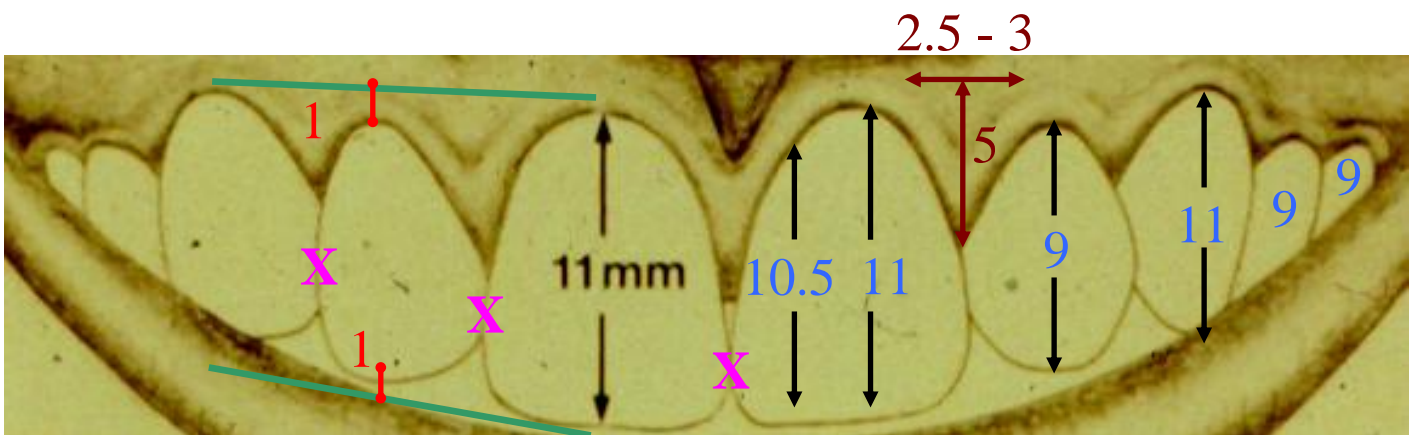


**X Contact Point: Centrals = Incisal Third; Central – Lateral = Incisal and Middle Third; Lateral – Canine = Middle Third** Lateral Incisor – 1 mm of gingiva coronal to a line from the incisal edge of the central & canine and incisal edge 1 mm apical to a line from the incisal edge of the central & canine. Line from central to canine should parallel the interpupillary line. 3 mm between the roots of teeth and 5 mm from the interdental bone to the contact point. The proper length of teeth.
